Table Captain Responsibilities

As a Table Captain for Bellwether's Closer to Home Fundraiser, you will invite and host a table of ten at the luncheon. Leading up to the event, you will invite these guests, ensure they register for the event, and invite new guests as needed to fill your table of ten. At the event, you will hand out our pledge cards. There will be an envelope with instructions at your table during the event.

INVITE:

Invite friends, colleagues, and family members interested in Bellwether Housing's work to join you at your table of ten at Closer to Home. Invite new guests as needed. We have created template invitation communications for your use (find them on page 4 of this guide). Send invitations and communications to guests as needed to ensure that you fill your table of ten. We ask that attendees make personally meaningful gifts to support Bellwether's mission. Our suggested minimum donation is \$240, however we are grateful for gifts of all sizes. If you are interested in filling more than one table of ten guests, please let Megan Mayes (mmayes@bellwetherhousing.org) know by September 12.

2REGISTER GUESTS:

Ensure your attendees register. Guests can register themselves using our online registration form found <u>here on</u>. <u>the Bellwether website</u>. Alternatively, you can email a list of your attendees to Megan Mayes, <u>mmayes@</u> <u>bellwetherhousing.org</u>. Please include their name, email, and meal preference: Fish or Vegan.

COORDINATE AT THE EVENT:

Act as a liaison for your table and your guests at the event. Hand out pledge cards to your table guests. There will be a moment when you are prompted to do this, along with instructions.

COMMUNICATE:

Send out email reminders as the event approaches (find template reminders on page 4 of this guide). Spread the word! Share our posts on social media and invite more folks to get involved. If guests can't attend, they can support our mission by <u>donating</u>. <u>through our online donation</u> <u>portal</u>, or by mailing a check. Thank your guests for attending and supporting Bellwether Housing.
